SEVEN HUNDRED BAPTIZED THROUGH FILMSTRIP BIBLE STUDY

Montgomery, AL - In the past nine years K. K. Mitchell, minister of the Southside Church of Christ, has been used by the Lord to baptize seven hundred people into Christ.

"For these past nine years I have been teaching the Bible using brother Jule Miller's Visualized Bible Study Series filmstrips and cassettes" Mitchell said. "They become increasingly valuable in my work. I know of no more dynamic and informative way to teach souls and bring them to accept God's way."

"Eighty per cent of those the Lord has won through my filmstrip Bible

studies are still faithful," Mitchell continued. "Persons are more likely to remain in the church after an extended study. We are suffering too many dropouts following the one-shot methods."

Three of those won through Mitchell's efforts are prominent ladies in the Montgomery area.

"Lois Byrd, a teacher at Alabama State University, Maggie Gardner, secretary for the housing authority, and Johnnie Royster, secretary to the president of Alabama State University are all now active members of the Southside Church of Christ. Before they were converted, they were Baptist and Methodist," Mitchell reported.

"After the filmstrip Bible studies they were all baptized into Christ. One obeyed at 11 P.M. one night, and the other two at 11 A.M. services.

"These ladies have been participants in house to house Bible classes and personal work classes. The Jule Miller filmstrips have been used in these efforts more than any other teaching method."
