SEVEN HUNDRED BAPTIZED THROUGH FILMSTRIP BIBLE STUDY

Montgomery, AL - In the past nine years K. K. Mitchell, minister of the Southside Church of Christ, has been used by the Lord to baptize seven hundred people into Christ.

“For these past nine years I have been teaching the Bible using brother Jule Miller’s Visualized Bible Study Series filmstrips and cassettes” Mitchell said. “They become increasingly valuable in my work. I know of no more dynamic and informative way to teach souls and bring them to accept God’s way.”

“Eighty per cent of those the Lord has won through my filmstrip Bible

studies are still faithful,” Mitchell continued. “Persons are more likely to remain in the church after an extended study. We are suffering too many dropouts following the one-shot methods.”

Three of those won through Mitchell’s efforts are prominent ladies in the Montgomery area.

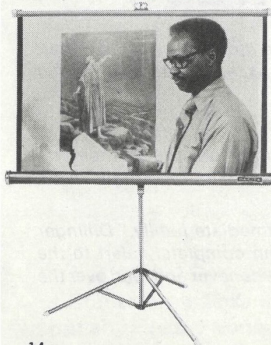

Before they were converted, they were Baptist and Methodist,” Mitchell reported.

“After the filmstrip Bible studies they were all baptized into Christ. One obeyed at 11 P.M. one night, and the other two at 11 A.M. services.

“These ladies have been participants in house to house Bible classes and personal work classes. The Jule Miller filmstrips have been used in these efforts more than any other teaching method.”

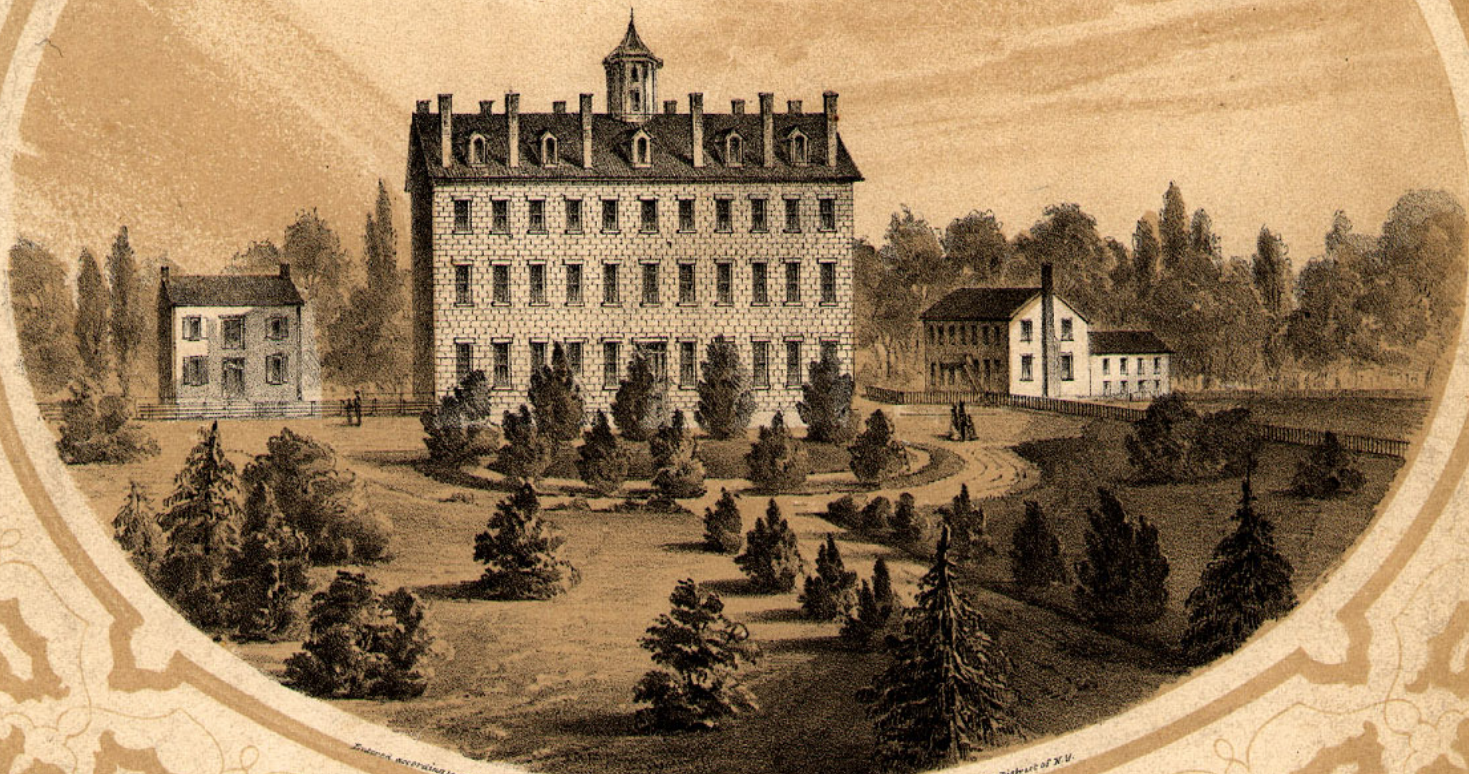

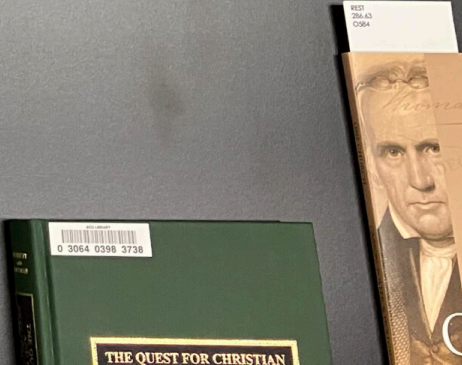
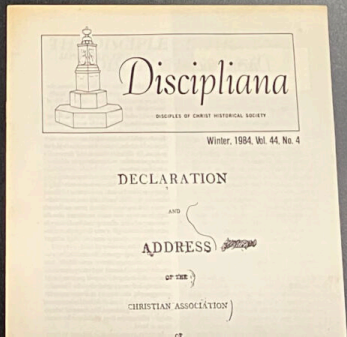
The Christian Churches which supported missionary societies had for several years gathered on an annual basis to receive society reports and to champion their causes. It was decided to hold the 1909 national convention in Pittsburg, the largest city nearest to Washington, Pennsylvania. It was, and remains, the largest such convention in Restoration Movement history, drawing some 50,000 attendees for the five-day meeting in October 1909.

This yard-long photograph of the communion service held at Forbes Field (with 26,000 communicants) indicates the vigorous support for the ideals championed by Thomas and Alexander Campbell as embodied by the Christian Churches and Churches of Christ. The Campbell family copy of the D&A formed the heart of the historical exhibits that week. In 1908 only one original copy was known to exist. By 1910, tens of thousands of copies were in circulation to ensure its availability in its second century far exceeded anything the Christian Association could have imagined in September 1809.

The Centennial Convention gave the D&A to the reading public on a scale simply unparalleled in the Movement's history. In that historical analysis and theological discussion rest on the availability of primary source material, it is no surprise that a renaissance of historical inquiry followed. A generation since then has not passed in which the D&A failed to receive scholarly and popular attention.

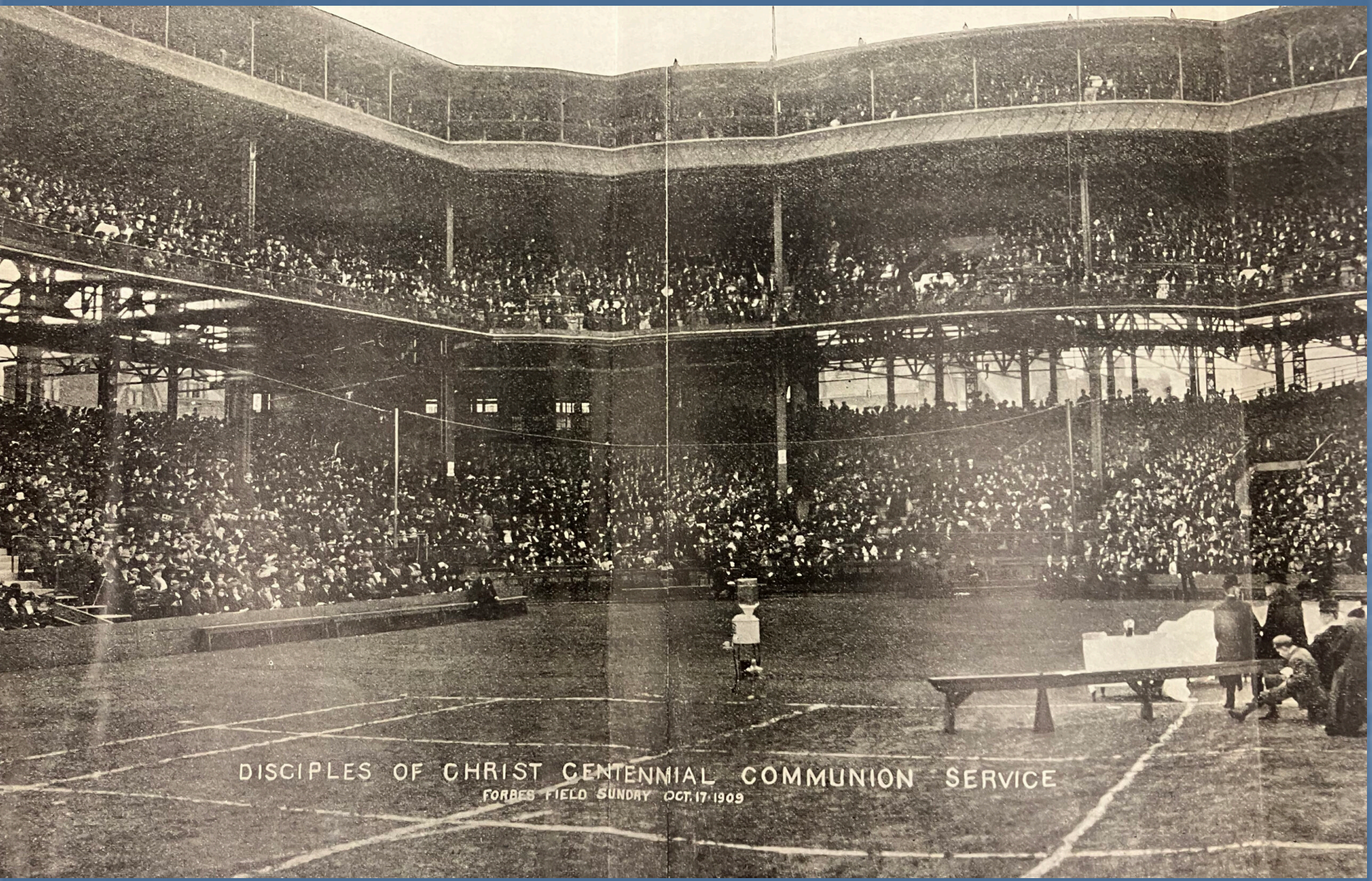


An Interpretation of the Thomas Campbell, Frederick D. G. Louis, 1923
